

Yellowstone School Upper Attendance and Credit Recovery Policy (High School)



In accordance with the **Texas Education Agency (TEA)** attendance requirements outlined in the **90% Rule** under **Texas Education Code (TEC), Section 25.092**, Yellowstone Schools adheres to the following guidelines for high school students to earn course credit.

Attendance Requirements for Course Credit

Students are required to attend at least **90% of the days a class is offered** to earn credit for that course.

Students who are required to enroll in Credit Recovery have exceeded the allowable number of absences as defined below:

- **Semester Credit Recovery:**
 - **Semester 1** (81 school days): More than **8 days** missed
 - **Semester 2** (94 school days): More than **9 days** missed
- **Full-Year Credit Recovery:**
 - More than **17 days** missed across the entire school year

Credit Recovery Courses

Credit Recovery is available for the following subjects:

- **Core Courses:** All Math, English, Science, and Social Studies classes
- **Foreign Language Courses**

Credit Recovery Requirements

Students enrolled in Credit Recovery must:

1. Complete all assignments assigned through **Imagine Edgenuity**.
2. Achieve a passing grade of at least **70%** in the course.

Access to Imagine Edgenuity

Students can access Imagine Edgenuity through **Clever**, both on campus and at home, to complete their coursework.
